



# Function And Feature Guide

- KC – Key Cylinder. (Commercial) Typically 1-1/8”
- MC – Mogul Cylinder.
- LEK – Local Electronic Keyswitch. Allows for electrical unlocking of locks via cylinder or as a request to exit. Commonly known as an ‘inmate function’.
- KCE – Key Cylinder Extension. Used with keyed-two sides locks or where frame depth exceeds standard dimensions used with cylinders alone. When required, frame depth dimension must be known prior to ordering.
- EHB – Electronic Hold Back. This function allows for electronic relocking when the lock is half-cycled (held unlocked) when the door is physically closed. Additionally, this function offers a remote relocking to a single door, or multiple doors via control center.
- TPR – Tamper Switch. Used to provide signal when lock’s roller-trigger is being depressed while a door is open. This feature is not available in junction with the EHB function.
- MHB – Mechanical Hold Back. When the lock is energized, this function will mechanically hold the lock in an unlocked position until the door is physically opened.
